What is Lions Lair?

- Lions Lair is Notre Dame Academy's before & after school program. It is available to all students in Kindergarten through 8th grade.
- Lions Lair strives to provide a safe and fun environment for all students who need care outside of the normal school day.

When is Lions Lair open?

- Before school: 7:00am to 8:45am
- After school: 3:55pm to 6:00pm
- During late starts and early releases
- On select non-school days from 7:00am to 6:00pm.


What will my student do in Lions Lair?

- Students will have the opportunity to participate in daily activities including homework help, creative projects, organized group games and free play.
- Students will spend time in the school cafeteria, gymnasium and outside on the playground.
- A light morning snack will be offered to students arriving before 7:45 and an afternoon snack will be provided for students attending after school.

How much does it cost?

- \$45 annual registration fee (per family)
- \$8 per time block, per student on regular school days
- \$55 per student, per day on non-school days
- Fees are calculated monthly and charged the following month to your TADS account.





How do the time blocks work?

Morning	7 - 7:45am	7:45 - 8:45am
Afternoon	3:55 - 5pm	5 - 6pm

- Students will be charged \$8 for each time block they are present for daily (shown above). Time blocks will be added up monthly and fees will be billed accordingly the following month.
- Ex: If a student is dropped off in the morning at 8:15am and picked up in the afternoon at 5:30pm, they will be marked as being present for 3 time blocks and will be billed \$8x3=\$24 for that day.

Can my student attend Lions Lair without registering?

- Unregistered students may attend Lions Lair before and after school as needed, but will be charged a drop-in fee of \$11 per time block.
- Unregistered students may not attend Lions Lair on non-school days and will not receive Lions Lair email updates during the school year.



Is Lions Lair open on non-school days?

- Lions Lair is open on select non-school days from 7:00am to 6:00pm.
- Students will be charged \$55 for each non-school day they attend.

What will students do on non-school days?

- On non-school days at Lions Lair, students will enjoy themed activities related to the holiday or season.
- Projects may involve arts & crafts, STEM, cooking, music, dance, language arts & writing and more!
- Students will also have the opportunity to play outside and in the school gym, and to visit the school library.
- On select days, field trips may also be offered. Please note, field trips may require an additional fee.

Should students bring a lunch from home?

- On select non-school days, hot lunch may be served by the school kitchen. More information will be available in the corresponding google sign-up form for each non-school day.
- Hot lunch charges would be billed to your TADS account.
- If hot lunch is not available, students must bring a lunch from home.
